## FROM THE PASTOR

Dear St. Joseph Parishioners,

For this weekend and next, our mission preacher, Fr. Dominik Urban, will be staying at the parish. Fr. Dominik and I met ten years ago while we studied canon law in Rome and have remained good friends. Fr. Dominik is from the Archdiocese of Bamberg, which was founded in the year 1007. He is assigned to a cluster of four parishes, all of which look like the inside of a Christmas snow globe. This region of Germany is called "Franconian Switzerland", because it is in the region of Bavaria called Franconia and because the landscape is filled with mountains and valleys. It is the most traditional part of Germany in terms of food, drink, music, festivals, etc.

This Sunday, March 5<sup>th</sup>, Fr. Dominik will preach the parish mission at 5:30pm. There will be a potluck supper beforehand. On Thursday, we will have a penance service at 6:00pm. Fr. Dominik and I will both be available at least until 7:00pm, but we will be happy to stay later, if needed.
