FROM THE PASTOR

Dear St. Joseph Parishioners,

If you saw the most recent clergy appointments for the archdiocese in The Catholic Voice online, you may have read that there is a change for me this year. It will not affect my assignment here in the parish, but it will affect some of my day-to-day duties. Currently, I serve as Archbishop Lucas' vicar for clergy and judicial vicar. That means that I have oversight in the archdiocese over all clergy matters and all matters pertaining to issues of canon law, which is the internal law of the Church. In July, I will take on additional duties as vicar general. The Code of Canon Law, the primary document which describes the internal law of the Church, describes the vicar general as follows: "By virtue of office, the vicar general has the executive power over the whole diocese which belongs to the diocesan bishop by law, namely, the power to place all administrative acts except those, however, which the bishop has reserved to himself or which require a special mandate of the bishop by law." Practically speaking, this means that the vicar general is the chief administrative officer of a bishop.

Since I already work fulltime at our chancery office, this should be no change in terms of time away from St. Joseph's. I remain deeply grateful to Archbishop Lucas for his confidence and for his assignment here. St. Joseph's is a wonderful parish, and being assigned here continues to be a source of life and joy for me.

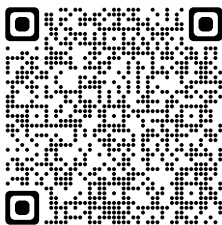

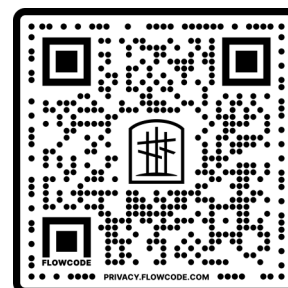


PRAYER FOR HEALING
