



Ladies' Guild Scholarship Application

- Scholarship applicants must:
 - be graduating in 2026 from a high school or home school program.
 - be a child of a registered St. Joseph member.
 - be accepted into a 2 or 4 year college or vocational school.
 - **Scholarships will be sent directly to the college the award recipient is attending. The check will be distributed after a student ID and mailing address is provided to the Ladies' Guild.**
- Application is due March 15, 2026 by 10 p.m. Place the application in the Ladies' Guild Mailbox. Mark on the envelope **Ladies' Guild Scholarship Application**.
- Application includes:
 - Volunteer/participation form
 - 250-500 word essay
 - The essay will be scored by three Ladies' Guild members and scored based on a rubric.
 - All applications will be anonymous to the scorers. An ID number will be assigned before grading.
- One \$1,500 scholarship and three \$1,000 scholarships may be awarded based on the total number of volunteer/participation points and essay scoring.
- You may fill out both a Ladies' Guild and Knights of Columbus application, but you can only receive one award.
