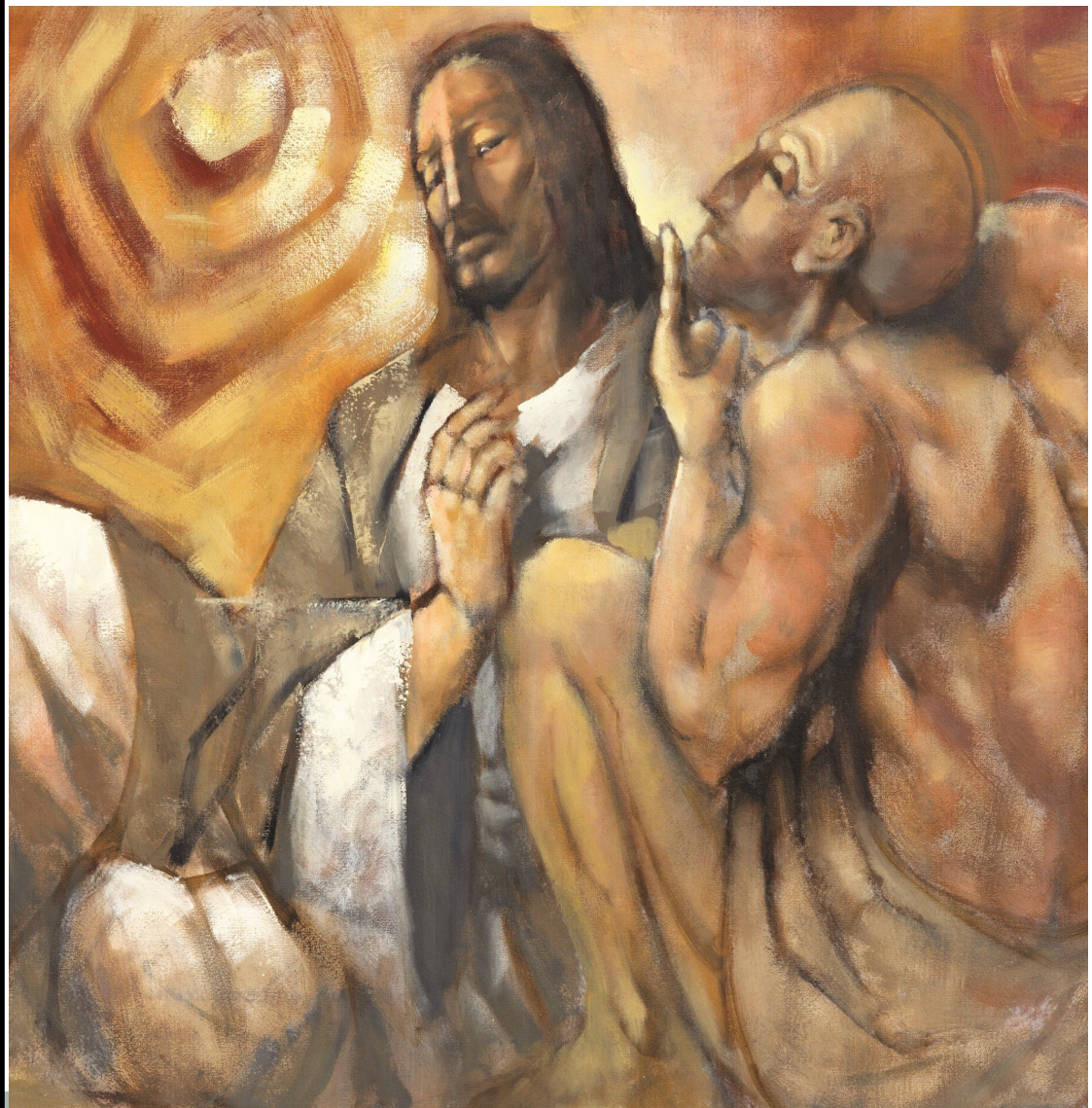

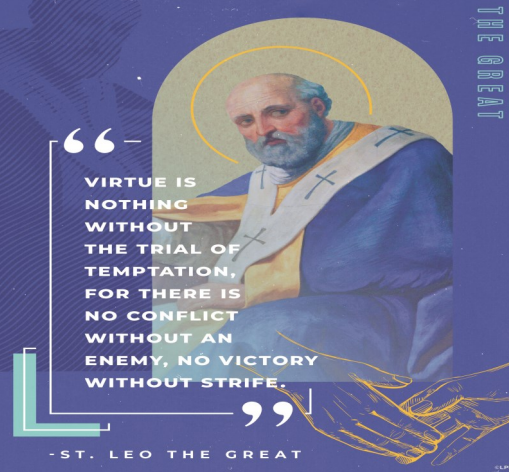
Join St. Joseph's Prayer Chain

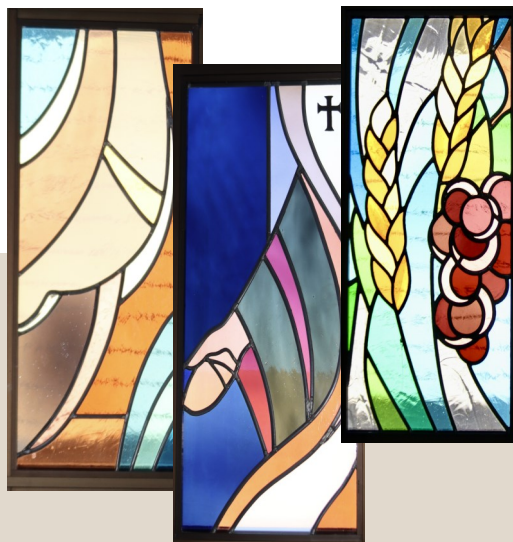
